REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

Mayor Lenseigne opened the Regular Council Meeting at 7:00PM.

1. APPROVE MINUTES FROM APRIL 20, 2023, CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Mayor Lenseigne asked if there were any corrections, additions, or omissions to the minutes of April 20, 2023. There were none.

ACTION NO. 1 Council member Roy made a motion to accept the minutes as prepared.
Council member Spurgin seconded the motion. The motion carried.

2. REVIEW BIDS FOR ILER STREET CRACK SEAL PROJECT.

City Supervisor Burkett informed the Council that on May 4, 2023, the City had a bid closing for the Iler Street Crack Seal Project. One bid was submitted by Central Paving LLC of Ellensburg, WA in the amount of \$67,035.00. The mayor read a letter from Ben Annen of HLA recommending the City accept the bid.

ACTION NO. 2 Council member Layman made a motion to accept the bid from Central Paving of Ellensburg for crack sealing.
Council member Frank seconded the motion. The motion carried.

3. YAKIMA VALLEY CRISIS RESPONSE UNIT INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT.

Police Lieutenant Lewis informed the Council that the Chief of the Yakima Police Department wants to begin charging for the SWAT team. The SWAT team was regionalized in the county to include all the cities. Lewis presented Council with a yearly percentage by population sheet for determining the Cities share, a rough draft of the SWAT team's budget, and the Interlocal Agreement(ILA). The projected date to have the ILA in place is January 1, 2024.

4. APPROVE ACCOUNTS PAYABLE & PAYROLL CHECKS AS IDENTIFIED ON THE CLERK'S JOURNAL

Council member Hutchinson seconded the motion. The motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

City Supervisor Burkett updated the Council on the status of the Beaudry Rd Water Reservoir. Burkett stated the City was getting close on completing this, but was waiting on an item with title company that needs to go through the City's attorney.

OTHER BUSINESS

Deputy Fire Chief Lamoureux spoke to the Council about the fire district and City's rating by WSRB which remained at a 5 in part thanks to the City's water department. Lamoureux says they will be asking the City to help by painting hydrants at a cost of about \$12 per hydrant.

Jennifer Beddard Spoke to the Council about hosting a Kids Farmers Market at the Moxee City Park that would be in conjunction with the Movie Night in the Park. Burkett also asked to have the process expedited and the fees waved due to it benefiting kids. The Council agreed.

Police Lieutenant Lewis updated the Council that the Flock Cameras are up and operational. He also stated the crime lab should be fully staffed in the next couple of months.




